Port Elizabeth and Gqeberha face persistent coastal winds. If you run events in any of these conditions, you need a marquee engineered for wind, not just marketed as "strong".

Our **wind resistant aluminum party marquee** uses 6082-T6 alloy - the highest-strength extrusion alloy commonly used in structural engineering - with reinforced columns, cross bracing at every bay, die-cast connectors and galvanized hardware. Structurally calculated for **100-120 km/h winds** with the recommended anchoring kit, this is the tent South African event professionals trust when the weather forecast turns ugly.

Safety is not a marketing claim here; it is engineering. Every configuration is analyzed with CAD structural calculation before production, and every frame is supplied with an anchoring specification for your site.

Q: What anchoring do I need for Cape Town summer? A: On grass, heavy-duty ground stakes plus rope kits are standard. On concrete or paving, ballast weights or concrete base plates. We specify anchoring per your site after ordering.

Q: Is it harder to assemble than standard marquees? A: Components are slightly heavier, but the numbered system and tool-

free pins keep assembly practical - typically 6-8 workers for a 20m x 30m structure.

Q: Can it stay erected permanently? A: Yes, with concrete base plates and periodic cover inspection, the frame is suitable for semi-permanent installations of several years.
